
Impact100 Launches Oakland County Chapter, Raises \$100K for Local Nonprofits

Oakland County, MI – May 10, 2016 – Impact100, a woman’s philanthropic group (501(c)(3)), announced the founding of a new chapter in Oakland County, Michigan, after successfully recruiting 100 women from the area. Each member donated \$1,000, resulting in the new chapter’s inaugural grant opportunity of \$100,000. Organizations interested in applying are invited to attend the Nonprofit Grant Application Workshop hosted at Shain Park Realty on **Wednesday, May 18 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.**
